CURRENT GUIDELINES ON THE RE-ENTRY OF MM2H PARTICIPANTS INTO MALAYSIA DURING RECOVERY MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (RMCO)

1. Effective from **5th October 2020**, MM2H Participant who is stranded abroad and wishes to re-enter Malaysia is **no longer required to register and obtain approval from the Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture (MOTAC)**. The procedure to re-enter Malaysia will be managed by the **Immigration Department of Malaysia**.
2. The transition of roles is to **standardize Government agency procedures** as well as to **ensure effective and efficient services to the customers involved**.
3. MM2H Participants who wish to re-enter Malaysia **MUST** register with **Immigration Department of Malaysia** and complete the required information via this link: <https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSf9Syq2Qoi-geICVjKNJ82waeEtlNk9fAJuN3FUKmPX00kvvg/viewform>
4. The request to re-enter Malaysia is **subject to the approval by the Director General of Immigration Department of Malaysia**.
5. **Depending on the current threat of COVID-19 in Malaysia**, the terms and conditions to re-enter Malaysia **may be revised from time to time**. Therefore, **any new requirement set by the Government of Malaysia upon entry is applicable to MM2H Participant unless otherwise stated**.
