



INTERNATIONAL MALAYSIA PASSPORT

You can apply for a Malaysian passport if you are a Malaysian. There are a number of circumstances in which your passport application may be rejected. Cause: violation, crime, court order, blacklisted, false or invalid document etc. It is the property and right of the Malaysia Government to do so.

Passport applications can be made at any Immigration office in Malaysia or Malaysian mission abroad. Our **Malaysian High Commission (Immigration)** is the passport issuing office in Europe. Our embassies (Consular) in Europe may assist Malaysians and forward passport applications to our London office. The whole process takes about 6 weeks depending on the situation.

The passport is valid for 5 years from the date of issue. Live image, thumb scan and thumbprint are taken directly at the Immigration counter.

The passport security process is linked with the **National Registration Department (Jabatan Pendaftaran Negara)** for checking and matching. This includes document checks. Make sure you have valid and up-to-date documents. Also, check your SSPI Blacklist status online to avoid complications.
