Extract MyKad JPN. KP 12 – apply for this if MyKad is lost or unreachable. Valid for use within 6 months. One time. If the MyKad is lost, you should get a replacement after the passport is replaced / renewed. If the ID version is old, your passport application will be rejected by the system.

- Malaysian birth certificate for applicants under 18 years of age (one of the parents must be present with the MyKad)
- Copy of the missing passport (if have)
- Valid Immigration Status Document permit i.e. <u>page in the passport</u> <u>containing the permit</u> / <u>immigration status document</u> A4 paper / <u>BRP card</u> / <u>immigration status online</u> validity print this (not the codes)
- Incident report (agency / police / fire station etc email / pdf / slip / letter); or
 'Lost Item' pdf certificate (www.immobilise.com / www.reportmyloss.com); or
- Malaysian marriage certificate / foreign civil marriage certificate registered <u>before</u> 1 March 1982 (non-Muslims) – if to add a married name)
- Emergency Travel Document* (if have)

CHECKLIST | DAMAGED PASSPORT

- IM 71 Pindaan 12/81 form
- The same documents as mentioned above (relevant)
- Cash payment: passport fee + penalty (double)
- Submission: Monday Thursday (9 am 12 pm) except public holidays
- **Collection**: 3 pm 4 pm * (the process can take up to 5 days if the evidence is insufficient, the status is doubtful or requires further investigation)
