

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### TYPE OF VISA

The type of visa depends on the **purpose of the visit** e.g. tourism, work, study, internship, to provide professional service etc.

- **Tourism:** length of stay depends on **nationality (passport)**.
- **Others:** length of stay depends on the **category (activity)**.

### SINGLE ENTRY VISA (£10)

Visa valid for up to 3 months. The period of stay starts from the date of entering Malaysia and up to the maximum allowed.

### MULTIPLE ENTRY VISA (£20)

Asian citizens (passport) are eligible to apply for MEV. Proof of journey more than one trip is required e.g. flight, train, bus, visa(s) etc. 30 days each entry within 3 months.

### EXTEND STAY

Extension can be granted on special consideration due to illness, accident, war in home country etc.

Families of Malaysian citizens or Malaysia permit holders may also be considered. Not all nationalities are allowed. Provide return ticket or visa and ticket to the next country. Fill in the IMM 55 form and apply in Malaysia.

### TRANSIT VISA

Foreign travellers in transit without leaving the airport and continuing journey to their next destination do not need a transit visa.

### SUBMISSION OF VISA

Visa submission should be made at the mission in the country of residence. If there is none, in a nearby country.

## YELLOW FEVER VACCINATION

Proof of yellow fever vaccination required for travellers aged 1 year or over **arriving from countries with risk of yellow fever transmission** and for travellers having **transited for more than 12 hours through an airport of a country with risk of yellow fever transmission**. Get vaccinated 10 days before travel because proof of vaccination is not valid until 10 days. Time is needed to develop immunity. The certificate of yellow fever vaccination is valid for 10 years.
